

Make It Better

As part of EdTechSA's 2023 Conference, students are invited to take part in the following competition.

Students are to choose one of the UN sustainability goals and design a digital solution or prototype that can improve the world. Some examples are:

- a game to educate players on how we can help sustain our ecosystems
- an app to help people improve their health
- a coded micro:bit that helps to conserve water
- a Virtual Experience that demonstrates the impact of global warming on our polar ice caps.
- a 3D Printed water filter that can be used during natural disasters



The final submission needs to be completed online. Students can submit a video (maximum 5 mins), pdf, jpeg or PowerPoint presentation (maximum 5 mins). The final submission must include the students name, year level, school, teacher name and teacher email address.

There are four main prizes, one for each of the following categories: Junior Primary, Primary, Middle School, Senior School. Winners will have their digital solution/prototype on display at EdTechSA's 2023 Conference and will be invited to present their solution during the conference.

Terms and Conditions

- Entry is free
- Students must be from SA Schools
- Winners need to be prepared to present their work at the EdTechSA ReBOOTEd 2023 conference
- All sites must obtain permission from parents/guardians to share student work or images on-line
- Entries will be judged by the EdTechSA Management Committee
- The number of entries permitted is unlimited
- Winners will be announced on May 30th, 2023 via the EdTechSA website and email to participant
- Entry can occur at any time between December 1 2022 to March 30 2023
- EdTechSA will seek the permission of entrants to be photographed and interviewed and to use their name, image and likeness for the purpose of announcing the winner to the public and in any articles or social media posts promoting the association.

Judging Criteria

Entries must be the work of students

Student entries will be judged on

- Creativity
- Alignment to one or more of the UN Goals for Sustainability
- Originality
- Evidence of use of a Design Thinking Process
- Evidence of alignment of student learning to the Australian Curriculum
